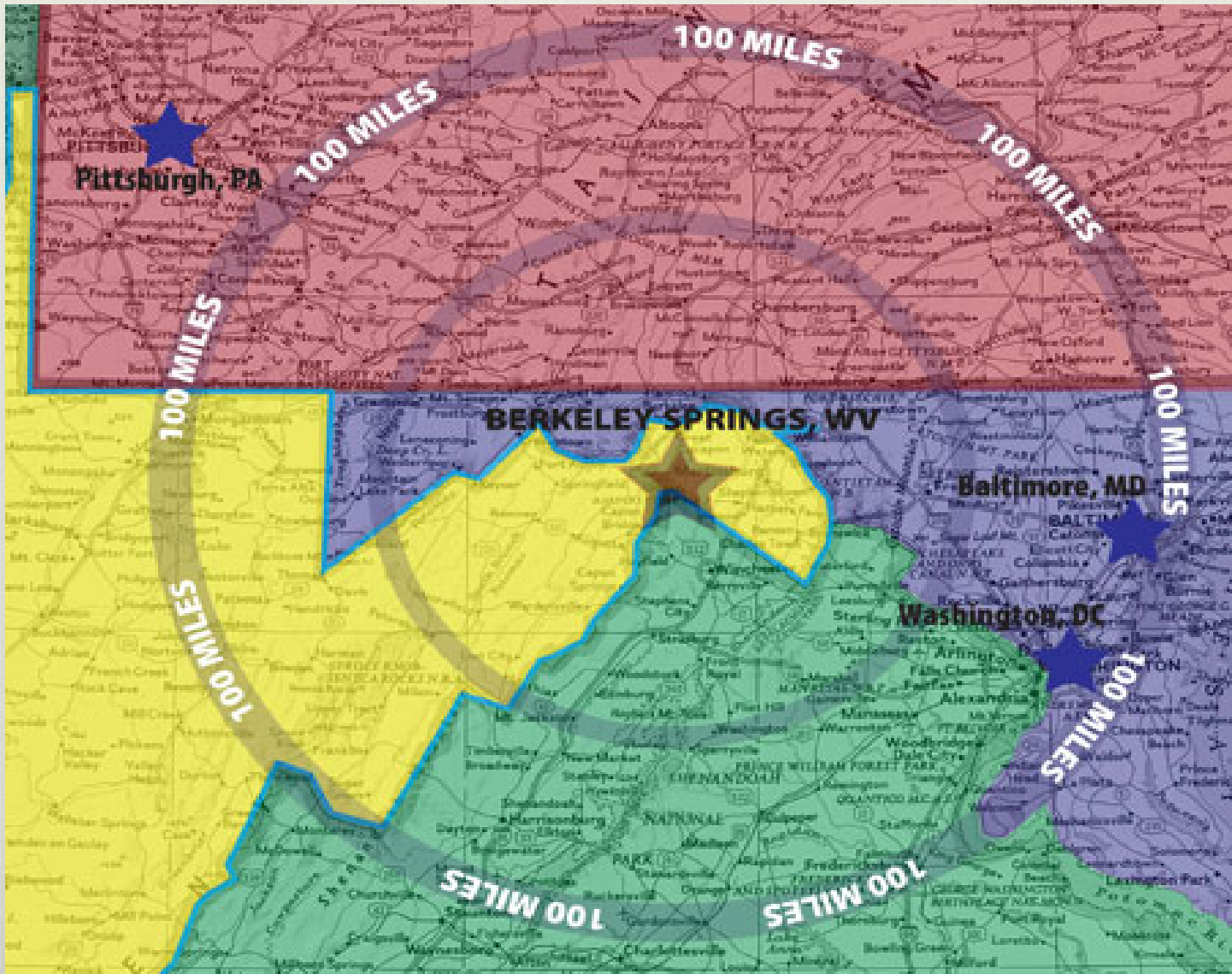

❖ 2012

- ❖ Alcohol, frequency of use, past 30 days 18.5%
- ❖ Cigarettes, frequency of use, past 30 days 15.5%
- ❖ Marijuana, frequency of use, past 30 days 11.5%
- ❖ Any illicit drugs monthly use 13.9%

❖ 2016

- ❖ Alcohol, frequency of use, past 30 days 12.4%
- ❖ Cigarettes, frequency of use, past 30 days 10%
- ❖ Marijuana, frequency of use, past 30 days 3.7%
- ❖ Any illicit drugs monthly use 11.2%

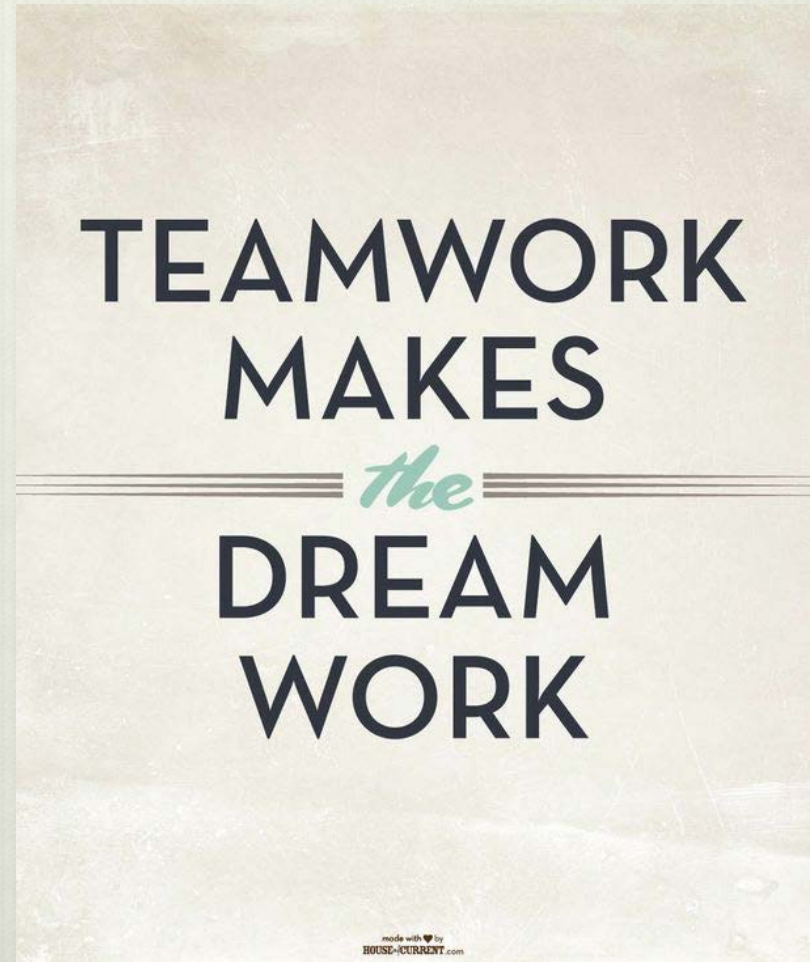
